Hiding the 'jog'

In the Facebook group there was a request for a video to learn how to hide the 'jog'. To show how you can hide the 'jog' I crocheted this little bag.

For this video I used a thicker cotton, so it is easier to see what I am doing. I intentionally started with blue and then switched to purple. I did this so you can really see what a 'jog' looks like.

The start of the round does not have to be a straight line. For this pattern the start of the round goes diagonally over the bag.


Right handed video, <u>Hiding the 'jog'</u> Left handed video, <u>Hiding the 'jog'</u> (<u>left handed</u>)



This little pattern, that I used for the video, has a repeat of 24 stitches. It is only a graph of the side.

Black line is the start of the round Red line is an increase Green line is a decrease
